ENTRY FEES

£25 for riders aged 13 & upwards

£12 for riders aged 12 & under

All entries must be made in advance. Entries close on Wednesday 12th September

£5 extra charge for entries received after closing date of Wednesday 12th September

All sponsorship money (minimum £5 per rider) payable to the Essex & Herts Air Ambulance Trust

All sponsorship payable on the day, not in advance

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The ride will take place in the area between Albury Hall and Brent Pelham (see www.countrytour.co.uk for directions) on Sunday 16th September 2018 starting at 9:30am with the last start time being 12.30pm. The ride is NOT competitive and will not be timed. All riders completing the course will be awarded a rosette.
2. Hard hats complying with modern safety standards must be worn at all times while mounted, along with suitable clothing & footwear. Back protectors are advisable. All horses/ponies' tack must be of a safe standard, properly fitted, and checked by the rider or their responsible adult prior to the start of the ride. It is advisable to carry at least one lead rope within each group.
3. Children aged 12 & under MUST be accompanied throughout the ride by a responsible adult of 18 years or over. Children aged 13-16 inclusive are permitted to ride unaccompanied provided that either their parent/guardian provides their consent to do so, or their responsible adult provides confirmation of the child's parent/guardian consent to do so.
4. No horses/ponies under 4 years old and no stallions.
5. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the ride, alter the route and times and retire any horse/pony or rider without stating a reason. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without stating a reason.
6. Riders MUST report to the secretary before commencing the ride to collect their number and pay their sponsorship money. They must also report to the secretary on completion of the ride. Riders MUST wear allocated numbers at all times.
7. All sponsorship money must be paid on the day at the secretary's tent before commencing the ride. The minimum sum is £5.
8. The route will be clearly marked and should be strictly followed to avoid damaging crops and other private property. Stewards will be present during the day. They are there for your safety so please follow their instructions.
9. Riders MUST ride safely and with consideration to others. Please ASK before passing other riders and do so IN WALK. Remember there are young horses and riders taking part!
10. Please do not drop litter.
11. Entry fees are non-refundable unless the organisers cancel the event.
12. Substitutes are allowed if a rider or horse/pony cannot participate for any reason but the organisers must be notified. If a rider is substituted, they must confirm their acceptance to these Conditions of Entry, & the consent referred to in 3 above must be provided, if applicable.
13. No dogs, bicycles or quad bikes allowed.
14. All riders understand and agree that they ride at their own risk and have their own adequate insurance. No liability for any damage to person, horse/pony or property, however caused will be accepted. Farrier/vet fees will be the responsibility of the owner/rider. **NO claim can be made against The Puckeridge Hunt or any of the organisers, for whatever reason.**
15. There will be a medic on the day and a veterinary surgeon on call.
16. Entry whether online or by post implies acceptance of all of these Conditions.

ALL ENTRIES TO BE MADE IN ADVANCE. NO ENTRIES ON DAY.

Entries close Wed 12th September. Entries received after this date classed as late entries (£5 surcharge per rider).

Start times are allocated on a first come first served basis. The sooner you enter, the more likely you are to have the time slot you would like.

ALL SPONSORSHIP PAYABLE ON THE DAY – NO SPONSORSHIP MONEY TO BE PAID IN ADVANCE PLEASE.
